The Operating Room remains the financial heart of the hospital generating 50% of revenue.

- 70% of cause-specific deaths; 23% of malpractice claims
- Surgical adverse events (AEs) occur in 3.6% of hospital admissions: 65% of all AEs
- Human factors were involved in the causation of 65% of surgical AEs: considered to be preventable

Surgery is the 2nd most common cause of MPL claims.

75% attributable to surgeon performance

35% is related to technical skill

10% is related to communication

5% is related to documentation*









After surgical performance, high contributors of inter-operative claims are Retained Foreign Body, Wrong Side/Site/Patient, and positioning.

Surgeons are challenged to do more with less time, affecting patient safety.

- Surgical Teams and OR assignments are often assigned on an "Ad Hoc" basis.
- Surgical units are facing a backlog leading to burnout.
- The OR is a "black hole" with no actionable data: what occurred, root cause analysis, and reports.
- The movement of more and higher risk procedures to bundled care agreements and lower cost settings.
